The final week of the program (Aug 19-23) will focus predominately on preparing students academically for easier integration into the Canadian public school system. Lessons will shift slightly away from cultural studies and towards key academic skills such as: Listening and Note Taking, Academic Essay Writing and Public Speaking/Debate skills. This week has been designed to give students who are going on to study in Canada a solid foundation for academic success, in addition to a greater cultural understanding and the English language skills obtained from the previous weeks of the program.
